Re: Uniform expectations

Uniform is an important part of the King's College Doha identity. It reinforces who we are as a community and helps allow pupils to feel pride in their school. It also ensures pupils are not put under any pressure because of the type of clothes they wear, and all are treated equally. As there can be different interpretations of what is and is not acceptable uniform, we believe it will be beneficial to clarify our expectations for pupils and parents in time for the start of the 2022-23 academic year.

Pre School – Year 2



Boys in Pre-School through to Year 2 should wear a white King's College polo shirt and have the option of grey shorts or grey trousers with grey socks and black polishable shoes. They may also wear a King's jumper when they wish to do so.

The girls should wear the King's dress and can wear a cardigan when needed. They should wear white socks and black polishable shoes.

Year 3 – Year 8

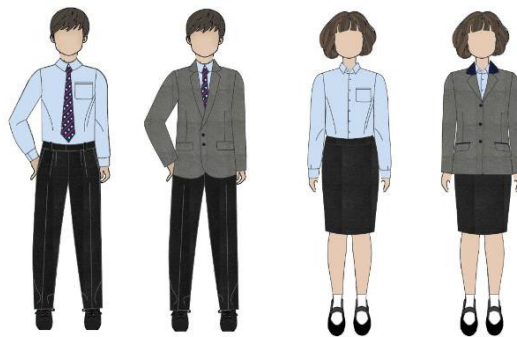


Girls in Year 3 to Year 8 must wear a white blouse (short or long sleeved) with their top button fastened and a King's College tie. They wear a school skirt and white socks and black polishable shoes. They should have a hair tie with them so that they can tie their hair back when participating in practical lessons. Girls are allowed to a single stud earring (gold or silver) and should not wear makeup.

The boys must wear a white King's shirt (short or long sleeved) with their top button fastened. They will also wear the King's tie. They have the choice grey shorts or trousers with grey socks and black polishable shoes.

Both the boys and the girls must have a blazer.

Year 9 and Year 10



Year 9 and 10 boys must wear grey trousers and a blue shirt with the Senior King's tie. The girls wear a blue blouse, grey skirt and white socks. All pupils must have a grey blazer and polishable black shoes.

PE / Swim kit



All pupils must have the King's College PE and Swim kit. This includes the PE top, shorts / skirt and tracksuit bottoms. For the girls swim wear, they can opt for the Arabic or non-Arabic swimsuit whilst the boys must have the King's swim shorts.

House kit

All pupils will need both a PE kit and House t-shirt. The House t-shirt colour will be dependent on the House that your child is in. To find this out, please contact Mr Kliber via e-mail at:

Our school uniform provider is **Globe uniforms**. They have an online shop (www.globeuniforms.ae/schools) where you can order the uniform you require and then collect it from King's. **Our school code is KC010 (zero, one, zero).** You can also visit their uniform shop at school which is currently open on Sunday, Tuesday and Thursday from 2pm – 5pm. As of the 1st of August, the uniform shop will be open daily and be located in the Sports Hall from 9am – 1pm and 2pm – 5pm.

In addition to the above, pupils may:

- wear a plain white undershirt (with no visible logos) beneath their uniform top, however it may only be visible at the neckline.
- wear a watch and girls may wear one silver or gold stud in the earlobe of each ear. Boys are not permitted to wear earrings or studs. No other jewellery may be worn unless this is for religious purposes, with an accompanying note from a parent/guardian.
- Hair must always be clean and tidy, worn off the face and styled so as not to invite comment for any reason. For practical subjects and for safety reasons, pupils may be required to tie their hair back so must have a hair tie with them. Hair may be coloured if of a natural colour, discrete and appropriate to a school environment.
- Boys must be clean shaven.
- Make-up is not permitted. This includes nail varnish.
- Black polished leather shoes are a uniform requirement. Training type shoes with or without logos, high heel, wedges, open toed sandals, sling backs or any type of fashion shoe are not permitted.
- Skirts must be at least to knee length.
